

Participate in the festivities by lighting two floating lanterns and a Kratong, which you'll release on the river for good fortune. Enjoy a traditional Northern Thai buffet while seated in VIP seating, giving you the perfect view of the mesmerizing lantern display and the accompanying demonstration show. Spend the night in Chiang Mai, reflecting on a day filled with culture, beauty, and celebration.

### DAY 4 NOVEMBER 6, 2025
