GATEWAYS Orientation

GATEWAYS ORIENTATION

Gateways Orientation will provide your student with opportunities and programs to discover what it means to live and learn in community during their first days at Holy Cross. Beginning on Move-In Day on Wednesday Aug. 21, 2024 through the evening of Monday Aug. 26, 2024, prior to the first day of class, new students will have the opportunity to make connections with their peers, settle into campus life and learn more about the important resources available to them as students at Holy Cross. Students will receive their individualized schedule for their required meetings during Gateways Orientation at Move-In Day. All new students are expected to fully participate in this required orientation program.

TEXTBOOKS NOW AVAILABLE

The textbook list is now <u>posted</u>. There will be free shipping from August 9 through August 29. (Some exceptions may apply.) The textbooks ship from Missouri, so take advantage of this offer to increase the chances that the books arrive in time for the start of classes. Searches are conducted by course number (i.e. PHIL110.01). If a course is not listed, it means that the professor has not yet placed an order for that class. Please keep checking back on the website. Do not order the books for a different section number as not all sections of the same class use the same books.

Please note: All books must be purchased online and shipped to the student box number. Textbooks are not in stock on campus. School supplies including notebooks, binders, calculators, and lab goggles can be found in the store on the first floor of the Hogan Campus Center, but textbooks are no longer sold on-site.

MAILING TO HOLY CROSS

Student mailroom box numbers can be found on their STAR account. Please do not use the words "P.O. Box" when mailing to campus as these are not true P.O. boxes, and packages addressed in this manner may instead be delivered to the central Post Office in downtown Worcester, creating significant delivery delays or possible lost mail.

You should use the below format and simply put the four digits on the same line as the last name. This format applies for all mail and packages that are sent to campus.

BANK MACHINES

Currently on campus we have a Santander Bank in the Hogan Campus Center. On Move-in Day representatives from Santander Bank and Bank of America will be on campus to assist students in setting up accounts should they desire to do so. They will be available at the Campus Connections Fair from 11 a.m. - 2 p.m. in the Hogan Ballroom.

DORMI RENTALS

Founded by Holy Cross alums, Dormi offers mattress rentals to students. They are an approved vendor for the College. <u>Learn more</u>.

MICROFRIDGE RENTALS

<u>Collegiate Concepts</u> is an approved vendor for students to rent a mico-fridge (one unit appliance, microwave, and mini-fridge in one). They will deliver the units to students' rooms prior to the start of the semester. If a student is instead looking to purchase a mini-fridge (no microwave), keep in mind that the mini-fridge has to be smaller than 3 cubic feet.
