As students have enrolled in fall courses and housing assignments will be out soon, this newsletter will turn our attention more to opportunities for students to get involved outside of the classroom. By no means is this comprehensive of all the opportunities available to students over their four years; these are some key options that hopefully your students will explore this semester.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

The <u>Office of Student Involvement (OSI)</u> offers a well-balanced co-curricular program that enriches the college experience and contributes to the development of the whole person – mind, body, spirit, and community. They create experiences that will expand student learning outside of the classroom and the development of their strengths, skills, and leadership that will serve them during college and beyond. OSI oversees a vibrant programming calendar throughout the year on nights and weekends, many of which are organized by the clubs and organizations described below.

CLUBS AND ORGANIZATIONS

Holy Cross has more than <u>100 clubs and organizations</u> (academic, club sports, media, multicultural, performing, peer education, philanthropic, religious, service, and special interest) that students can get involved with on campus. Groups have their own unique purpose and sponsor a range of events.

The Co-curricular Extravaganza is the annual clubs and activities fair, hosted by the Purple Key Society and OSI. This year's event will be held on **Saturday, Sep. 14**, from 3-6 p.m. Students should watch their emails for details.

OFFICE OF THE COLLEGE CHAPLAINS

The <u>Chaplains' Office</u> serves to strengthen the spiritual life of the Holy Cross community through retreats, community service, pastoral care, and worship. They support students of all religious backgrounds. Their office is located in Campion House (the white house pictured above) and is well known for its welcoming and comfortable atmosphere. They offer a range of <u>retreats</u> throughout the year that are hosted off-campus at the College's retreat center, The Joyce Contemplative Center (JCC).


Preparing to Live On-Campus
